

## **NGA-LAILG Billing Policy – updated 2019**

### LAILG Billing Policies, July 2018-June 2019

The enrollment process consists of paying dues, filling out required paperwork, and attending two hours of continuing education each year.

#### Yearly enrollment costs include:

- \$170 per acre
- \$150 per site
- \$375 Plant California Alliance Dues
  - \$750 for operations with annual gross crop sales of more than \$1 million.

#### New Enrollees

All new enrollees will incur a one-time enrollment fee of:

- \$975 for less than 5 acres
  - \$1475 for 5 acres or more
- New enrollees for businesses that have been operating during the 5-year waiver period will also be required to pay dues/fees owed from the start of each 5-year waiver period.

#### Re-enrollment

Businesses previously enrolled in the program that have left voluntarily or due to non-payment will be subject to paying all past-due invoices.

#### Financing

A one-time in-house 0% interest financing plan is available for six months with an administrative fee of \$20/month. In order to qualify, you must comply with all other requirements of the Conditional Waiver.

#### Expulsion from the Group

The board recognizes that the fees are a hardship and that equity in payment is essential. Therefore, growers that are more than 6 months past due will be automatically expelled from the group and reported to the Water Board.
